Vegetation shall be established and evenly distributed throughout the site with no visible erosion. Sites disturbing more than one (1) acre are required to contact Lucas County Soil & Water Conservation District at 419-893-1966.
2. Lucas County Engineer requires a Special Flood Hazard Area Development Permit in an identified flood hazard area
