

## Public Notice Jerusalem Township Prohibited Growth of Grass & Weeds

To all owners, lessees, agents or tenants owning or having charge of land within Jerusalem Township which has noxious weeds, tall grass and/or rank vegetation about to spread or mature seeds growing on the same, take notice that said noxious weeds, tall grass and/or rank vegetation must be cut and destroyed. First offense in the calendar year shall cause a written notice to be served upon the owner, lessee, agent, or tenant having charge of such land by ordinary US mail notifying them that such noxious weeds or grass are growing on such lands and that they must be cut and destroyed within seven days after the service of such notice.

Failure to comply with this notice shall result in the Township causing such noxious weeds, tall grass and/or rank vegetation to be cut and/or destroyed at a rate of \$250 per hour with a minimum of two hour per occurrence. All costs and expenses including the cost of giving notice, incurred by the Township, in cutting and/or destroying said noxious weeds, tall grass and/or rank vegetation shall be a lien upon the property which they are removed and if the same are not paid within (20) days after they are incurred by the Township, they shall be certified to the Lucas County Auditor who shall place the same on the tax duplicate.
