While you review the basic procedures, please keep in mind the single-most important factor is creating a safe and contained way for your household trash to be collected. It is absolutely necessary to keep the driver in the truck as much as possible.

In the next few years, all collection will be performed by automated trucks. Receiving collection carts is the first step toward that improved system.

Please do not purchase carts. You must use the carts provided.

Your New Trash Collection Process





Dear Jerusalem Township Residents,

Beginning April 2022, the Township is modifying the residential curbside trash collection program to embrace automation and enhance the cleanliness of our community.

While we understand that change is disruptive, we intend to make this process as easy as possible.

As a resident of Jerusalem Township, you will automatically be enrolled and receive a single Republic Services 96-gallon cart before the end of March. Please note: once you receive the new Republic Services[®] cart, your personal containers can no longer be used.

Under the program, the first cart is included; however, if you wish to receive additional carts, you must call Republic Services at **734.848.3633** to individually subscribe and pay for the multiple cart service. The fee for each additional cart is **\$6.25 per month.**

If you currently have a Republic Services tote which you are paying a rental fee for, you will see that rental fee disappear and receive a refund for any amount you paid past April 1, 2022. If you have multiple carts, you will continue to see a invoice for the number of carts exceeding one.

Accepted Materials

These items can always be placed in your trash cart:





Bagged waste

Pizza boxes/soiled recycling

Broken household items (such as vacuums, lamps and other small broken home goods)

Non-Accepted Materials

These items should never be placed in your trash cart:





Yard waste

Construction materials

Monthly Bulk Item Program

Residents within Jerusalem Township can place one bulk item per month on their collection day during the second full week of the month. Acceptable bulk items include furniture, appliances not containing Freon®, mattresses, trunks, toys and bundles of carpeting (maximum of 4' long, 2' wide, and weighing no more than 40 pounds). Unacceptable bulk items include hazardous waste of any kind, large auto parts (weighing more than 50 pounds), tires, appliances containing Freon®, construction debris, broken concrete and yard waste.
