

Target zoning enforcement in the Township for 2023 will be Junk Vehicles

Noted in the Township Comprehensive Plan, blight, junk vehicles, tall grass & noxious weeds are a major concern of residents.

What is considered a Junk Motor Vehicle according to Ohio Revised Code?

- 1. Three (3) model years old, or older
- 2. Apparently inoperable
- 3. Extensively damaged (missing wheels, tires, engine or transmission)

Township Zoning Resolution states:

"Storage of "junk vehicles should be in a completely enclosed building"

How will I be notified?

- 1. Informal order sent via regular mail Seven day compliance period
- 2. Board of Trustees declares violation.
- 3. Formal Orders sent to the property owner. Fourteen days to abate the issue or appeal.
- 4. If not abated, the township will send a licensed motor vehicle salvage dealer to remove.

Township is asking residents to take a look at cars, boats, and trailers that may be qualified junk.

There are several ways to get these removed before violations are sent out.
