Zoning Change Request

A zoning change request from C-2 Commercial to A/R Agricultural Rural Residential for the property located at 9815 Corduroy Rd & 9825 Corduroy Rd (partial). This is scheduled to be heard by the Plan Commission on April 22, 2026.
